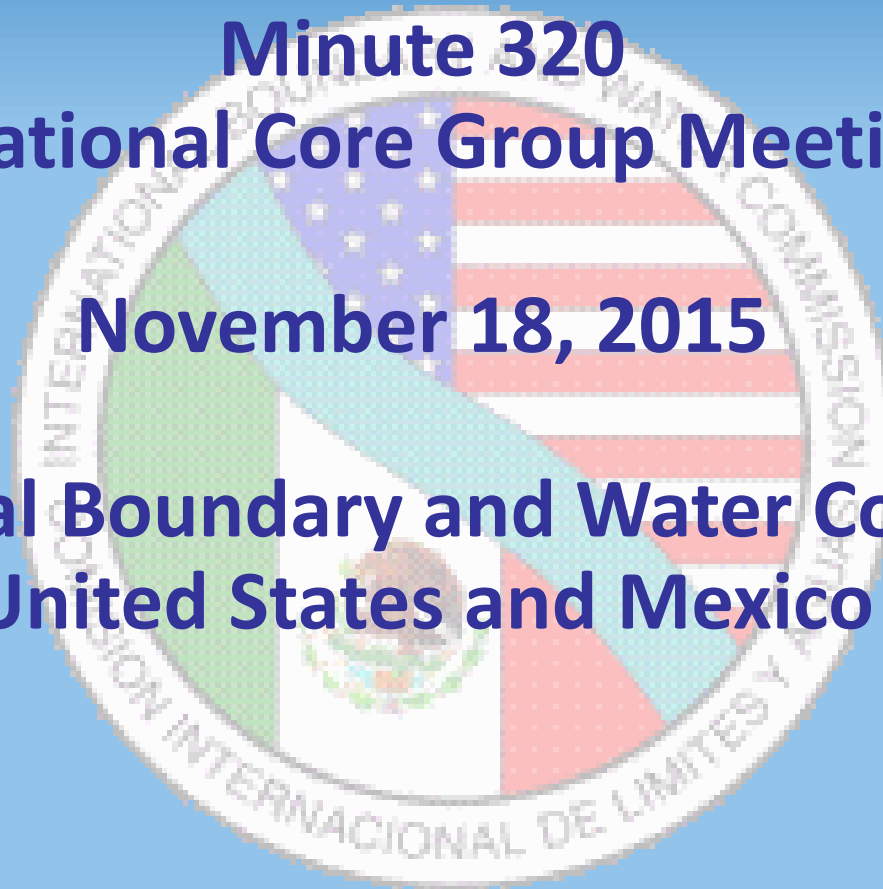

Three Binational Working Groups

- 1) Sediment Control
- 2) Solid Waste
- 3) Water Quality



Members

- 1. Members of the Binational Working Groups shall be nominated by members of the BCG or the Commission and approved by the Commission.**
- 2. Nominations for BWG members should be provided to the Commission no later than December 4, 2015.**
- 3. Nominations should be submitted to Principal Engineers or Area Managers.**
- 4. BWG members can be from the BCG or from other agencies.**



BWG Meetings

- 1. Meetings will be held monthly (or as determined by the respective BWG groups), alternately in the US and Mexico.**
- 2. The first BWG meetings should be scheduled for the week of January 18, 2016 and will be chaired by the local IBWC area managers, Roberto Espinosa in Tijuana and Steve Smullen in San Diego.**
- 3. BCG and BWG meetings will not be held concurrently.**
- 4. Simultaneous translation will be provided.**

1. **US- City of San Diego, County of San Diego, IBWC, Navy, CA State Parks, NGOs, TRNERR, CA Regional Water Quality Control Board, EPA.**
2. **Mexico- Ayuntamiento de Tijuana (DSPM & DOUIM), CESPT, NGOs, CONAGUA, SEMARNAT, SEDUE(DSPM)**
